<u>Ingredients</u>

1022 Angled Rim Charger
1021 Angled Rim Dinner Plate
1020 Angled Rim Salad Plate
1019 Angled Rim Dessert Plate
FS2300-Polar Bear
FS2314-Black Lab
Color Stix 6 Soft Fan Brush #6541
Ultimate II brush 6 #6602
Ultimate II brush 4 #6601
Tissue Paper
Pencil
Sharpie Marker/Fine Point
Sponge



Directions

Angled Rim Charger:

- **Step 1** Using the Fan Brush, cover the top of the charger with 3 coats of Polar Bear. Be sure to let the paint dry between applications.
- **Step 2** Using pencil; trace the dog on the tissue paper. Next, place the tissue paper on platter in desired location and trace using the Sharpie Marker.
- **Step 3** Side load the larger brush and outline the dog in Black Lab. Let dry.
- **Step 4** Add a small amount of water and Polar Bear to some Black Lab. Use this and the smaller brush (side load), to add shadows around the inside of the dog's body. Let dry.
- **Step 5** Using the Fan Brush, cover the back of the charger with 3 coats of Black Lab. Be sure to let the paint dry between applications.
- **Step 6** Wet sponge and wring out excess water. Dab sponge in Black Lab. Gently drag the sponge around the outside edge of the charger to create an even black boarder. Be sure to dab sponge into paint often to keep it wet with paint. Let dry.

Dip piece in Gare 9000 non-toxic glaze. Let dry. Fire to cone 06. Complete the rest of the pieces in this set following the directions listed above.
