



POTTERY PAINTING PLACE

Class: Look to the Masters

Recipe: Frank Lloyd Wright Vase

Piece:

Gare Square Herb Vase # 5094

Supplies Needed:

- Medium Rectangle Brushes
- Masking Tape
- #2 Pencil

Gare Paints:

- FS-2391 Red Blaze
- FS-2315 What-a-Yolk
- FS-2381 BeBoppin' Blue
- FS-2314 Black Lab



Planning Stages:

Start off by sketching out a general plan for where you want everything. This map for everything is a guide to help in the painting process, but it can be tweaked and adjusted as you start painting.

Masking Tape and Painting:

Apply masking tape around the squares of where you want the color. Use a medium square brush to paint three coats of paint in Red Blaze, What-A-Yolk, or BeBoppin' Blue. When the colors dry, then start adding the black lines to outline and grid around the vase. This can be a tedious and cumbersome process that involves taping each area, painting them with three coats, and then lifting the tape and masking off new areas. Patience is a virtue (☺)... and the more lines and detail you add to your grid, the more patience you will need! However, if you invest the time and energy, the product you get from it is worth it! Finish by signing the bottom!
