# **Wedding Set**

## Ingredients

1602-Classic Rim Charger 1025-Peasant Ware Salad Plate 2034-Peasant Ware Cereal Bowl 1004-Classic Coupe Salad Plate 1603-Petal Soup Bowl

2306-Blue-by-U Fun Writers

6541-Soft Fan Brush Sponge Cricut or Stencils



You may cut your "patterns" out using the Cricut or create your own. If you
are using paper for your stencils, wet them and this will help the stencil
stick to the bisque while you are painting over them. I use Avery mailing
labels when I need to stencil on unpainted bisque as I find they stick well
and do not leave glue on the bisque which will cause crawling.

### Directions

### **Classic Coupe Salad Plate**

#### Step 1

Center letter stencil in the middle of the plate. Dab sponge in paint, then dab on scrap bisque or paper before sponging paint onto plate. Fill in entire letter and let dry. Apply paint 3 times.

### Step 2

Pick up a good amount of paint with the sponge. Rest the outside edge of the plate into the sponge/paint and turn plate. Move paint around the rim in this manner until the entire edge is covered. Let dry and repeat.

### Step 3

Using the Fun Writer filled with Blue-by-U, "dot" around the inner edge of the plate, (next to the rim just painted with sponge). Let dry.

Repeat Steps 1-3 for Peasant Soup bowl and Petal Soup bowl.



### **Peasant Ware Salad Plate**

### Step 1

Center letter stencil in the middle of the plate. Dab sponge in paint, then dab on scrap bisque or paper before sponging paint onto plate. Fill in entire letter and let dry. Apply paint 3 times.

# Step 2

Apply vine/swirl stencil at top and bottom of plate, (centered on letter). Cover plate with 3 coats of Blue-by-U. Let paint dry between coats.

#### Step 3

Let paint dry completely. Remove stencils. If any paint is removed, replace and let dry.

Dip in Gare 9000D. Fire to cone 06.
