Planted in Love Bridal Plate

Ingredients

Fun Strokes

FS 2305 Blue Heaven
FS 2308 In The Pink
FS 2314 Black Lab
FS 2321 Berry Nice
FS 2325 Happy Go Lucky
FS 2349 Tweety Bird
FS 2354 Something Blue
FS 2368 Old Yeller

Bisquefire

1013 Coupe ChargerGlazes
GG 1700 Clear Dipping Glaze

Brushes

980-6 Ultimate Round brush
Ultimate Liner Brush

STEP 1- Sponge ware to remove dust.

STEP 2- Using a small synthetic sponge apply the following colors to achieve a rainbow effect. Sponge 1 coat of Something Blue to the top section of the plate. Rinse the sponge with water, then lightly sponge 1 coat of In The Pink to the middle section of the plate. Rinse the sponge again, the apply Tweety Bird to the lower section, followed by 1 coat of Old Yeller to the very bottom edge.

STEP 3- Trace the pattern using Saral or tissue paper.

STEP 4- Using the #6 ultimate Round brush, fully load with Blue Heaven. Begin the stroke from the edge of petal and work toward the center. Apply two strokes of color to form each petal. Reload the brush to form each stroke. Repeat this using Berry Nice to form the petals on the remaining flower.

STEP 5- Apply 1 coat of Happy Go Lucky to the leaves and the stem.

STEP 6- Apply 1 generous coat of Old Yeller to the flower centers.

STEP 7- Use the liner brush, fully loaded with Black Lab to fill in the lettering and date. Allow colors to dry.

STEP 8- Dip into GG1700 Clear Dipping Glaze. Fire to shelf cone 06.
