Wedding Votives

INGREDIENTS

Bisquefire

#5013 Rim Tea Light/ Votive & 5014 Rim Wine/Candle Holder

Fun Strokes

FS- 2300 Polar Bear FS- 2308 In The Pink FS- 2371 Coffee-n-Cream

FS- 2378 Pea Soup

Bumpy Doodles BD 2502 Bumpy Pink

Glaze

1700D Clear Dipping glaze

Brushes & Materials # 6520 3/0 Detail Brush 1 Fun Writer Bottle Synthetic Sponge

- **Step 1-** Squeeze out about a quarter size amount of the following colors on a tile or palette: Polar Bear and In The Pink.
- **Step 2-** Dip your sponge in water and squeeze out water but don't squeeze completely. Leave some water in the sponge and drip it onto the center of the glazes on your palette. Dab into the two colors and apply to the rim of the small votive. Don't play around with it too much. This should take seconds and should be pretty wet. The pink should be VERY light and scattered. Let dry. It should take a minute or two. Do exactly the same using Coffee-n-Cream and Polar Bear on the inside of the small dishes and the entire large candle holder.
- **Step 3-** Trace pattern onto the rim of the larger candle holder and apply one thin coat to the hearts and the roses. Apply one coat of Pea Soup to the stems and the leaves.
- Step 4- Sponge on one full coat of In The Pink to the edge of the rim on the candle holder.
- **Step 5-** Fill a fun writer bottle with Polar Bear and outline the hearts and the roses and a little on the leaves.
- **Step 6-** Apply dots of Bumpy Pink to the rim edge as shown in photo.
- **Step 7-** Dip into clear glaze and fire to shelf cone 06.
