Fun Writers

Duck brand painters tape-1" wide
Tissue paper
Sharpie Maker fine point
Pencil

Directions

To transfer pattern to bisque: trace pattern onto tissue paper using pencil. Lay tissue paper onto bisque placing the pattern in desired position pencil side up. Trace over pattern using Sharpie Marker. Remove tissue paper and paint in pattern. Sharpie outline will disappear with firing.

8 x 3 x 8 Wide Rectangular Vase

Step 1 - Tape out a square in the upper left of vase measuring about 5 x 5. Run a piece of tape along the bottom of the vase. Paint the area between the two taped areas with 3 coats of Smiley Face.

Step 2 - Remove tape from bottom and paint with 3 coats of Orange Crush.

Step 3 - Remove tape from square.

Step 4 - Transfer patterns, (writing and flower boarder) to vase.

Step 5 - Use Fun Writer and Orange Crush for lettering.

Step 6 - Outline square using Fun Writer and Something Blue. Let dry and dot with Li'l Boy Blue.

Step 7 - Fill in flowers with Fun Writers and brushes using picture as guide for colors.

Always let area painted dry completely before continuing on to next side.

Step 8 - Tape side in horizontal stripes from bottom to top. Remove every other piece of tape. Paint exposed bisque with 3 coats of Tweety Bird. Let dry completely and then recover in tape. Remove remaining strips of tape and paint bisque in 3 coats of Orange Crush. Dry and turn to next side.

Step 9 - Using fan brush, cover entire side with 2 coats of In the Pink. Brush a bit hard to leave a streaky effect. Let dry.

Step 10 - Transfer pattern, (oval with "life is good") and fill in using Fun Writers. Free-hand the flowers outside the center oval using Fun Writers. Let dry and turn.

Step 11 - Follow step 8. After exposing a strip of bisque, paint either $\frac{1}{2}$ or $\frac{1}{4}$ of that strip in one color and remainder in another. Strip can also be divided into 3rds and 3 colors applied. See picture. Let dry.




Dip in Gare 9000D and fire to cone 06.

Using pictures and listed colors, supplies and patterns, finish the remaining vases in the set. If you don't find a pattern for a flower below it is because the item was free-hand drawn in.


