Class: Samples That Don't Just Look Pretty

Recipe: New Year's Resolution Platter

Piece:

Gare Classic Casual Coupe Dinner Plate #1607

Supplies Needed:

- Large Square Brush
- Round Yellow Sponge
- Banding Wheel
- #2 Pencil

Gare Paints:

- STRIPES- FS-2376 Bouncin' Berry, FS-2343 Peachy Keen, FS-2323 Jumpin' Juniper, FS-2391 Red Blaze, FS-2315 What-a-Yolk
- RIM- FS-2314 Black Lab Regular paint
- OUTLINE – FS-2314 Black Lab Fun Writer
- FLOWERS- FS-2314 Black Lab Fun Writer



Stripes:

With a #2 pencil, sketch an approximate location for each stripe. Use a large square brush to paint three coats of each color on each stripe. Using a Black Lab Fun Writer, make two black thin outlines on the edges of the stripes. The stripes do not have to be exactly straight because they look fun and whimsical when they are slightly imperfect. Handmade charm at it's best!

Words, Outline and Flowers:

Use a Black Lab Fun Writer to write your own personalized resolutions in the stripes. Then, also using the Black Lab Fun Writer, scatter flowers throughout the platter in the spaces left after you have added all your writing.

Rim:

Place the plate on a banding wheel, and make sure that it is centered. Dip a round yellow sponge into Black Lab Paint. Now, place the sponge on the edge of the platter and spin the banding wheel at the same time. Go over the edge about three times to ensure that the black rim ends up solid.
