**INGREDIENTS** 

FS- 2308 In The Pink FS- 2314 Black Lab

1700D or 9000D Clear Dipping

Bisquefire #3026 Swoop

FS- 2323 Jumpin Juniper

Glaze

Sushi Long Narrow Platter

FS- 2345 Goldfish

**Brushes & Other Materials** 6503 Colorstix #4 Round Brush

**Fun Strokes** 

FS- 2349 Tweety Bird FS- 2374 Blue Ice

Fun Writer Bottle

FS- 2300 Polar Bear FS- 2304 Green Acres FS- 2375 Jumpin Jelly

**STEP 1-** Apply 2 thin coats of Polar Bear to the top of the plate.

STEP 2- Pour out some Blue Ice about the size of a quarter and the same with Polar Bear aside of the Blue Ice. Dip your sponge in water. Squeeze some of the water out near your blue and white glaze. Dab the rounded part of the sponge into the two glazes and the water but using mostly Polar Bear. The blue should be very watered down. You need to do this only once because you already have 2 coats of Polar Bear on your plate.

STEP 2- Clean off sponge and squeeze out the water. Dip into the Blue Ice and sponge on the rim of the plate.

STEP 3- Trace Pattern. Apply Goldfish to the noses. Apply all the following colors by doing just one coat so it looks like watercolor. If you want deeper tones then you can apply heavier. First snowman has Blue Ice buttons and a Green Acres hat. The second snowlady has In The Pink and Blue Ice hat and scarf and Jumpin Jelly flower buttons. The third snowgirl has In The Pink hat, mittens and flower button. The forth snowlady has a Tweety Bird and Jumpin Juniper hat and a Jumpin Jelly, In The Pink scarf.

STEP 4- Fill the writer bottle with Black Lab and outline all the snow people. Write names across the bottom or Happy Holidays. Using the back of a brush, you can dot with Blue Ice to make snowflakes.

STEP 5- Dip into 1700D or 9000D Clear Dipping Glaze and fire to a cone 06.
