Snuggle Inn

project time -4 hours



INGREDIENTS

BISQUEFIRE

3003 Platter
7070 Small Ornament
7071 Large Ornament

FUN STROKES

FS-2300 Polar Bear
FS-2314 Black Lab
FS-2325 Happy Go Lucky
FS-2326 Fir Ever Green
FS-2337 Lil Boy Blue
FS-2338 Galaxy
FS-2350 Golden
Retriever

FS-2361 Leap Frog
FS-2366 Chocolate
Moose
FS-2368 Old Yeller
FS-2378 Pea Soup
FS-2390 Orange Crush
FS-2392 Rockin Red

Materials:

6 Round Brush
Detail Brush
Mop Brush
5 Fun Writer Bottles
Synthetic Sponge

STEP 1- Fill 5 Fun Writer bottles with the following Fun Stroke colors: Old Yeller, Happy Go Lucky, Lil Boy Blue, Rockin Red and Black Lab. Put aside.

STEP 2- Divide the platter by drawing a line with a pencil across the center to separate the sky from the snow. Do this in a wavy pattern like shown in the photo or you can trace it from the pattern.

STEP 3- Apply two coats of Polar Bear to the bottom half of the platter and 3 coats of Galaxy to the top half of the platter.

STEP 4- Trace Pattern.

STEP 5- Apply 2 coats of Golden Retriever to all of the sign. Use a slight amount of Chocolate Moose and side load some color on a small brush and apply some lines to make a wood grain. Also apply a couple of wood knots on the wood grain. See step 7 for side load shading.

STEP 6- using the colors in the fun writer bottles, apply one coat to each of the houses going around the windows leaving the Polar Bear showing through underneath. Let the houses dry before you shade.

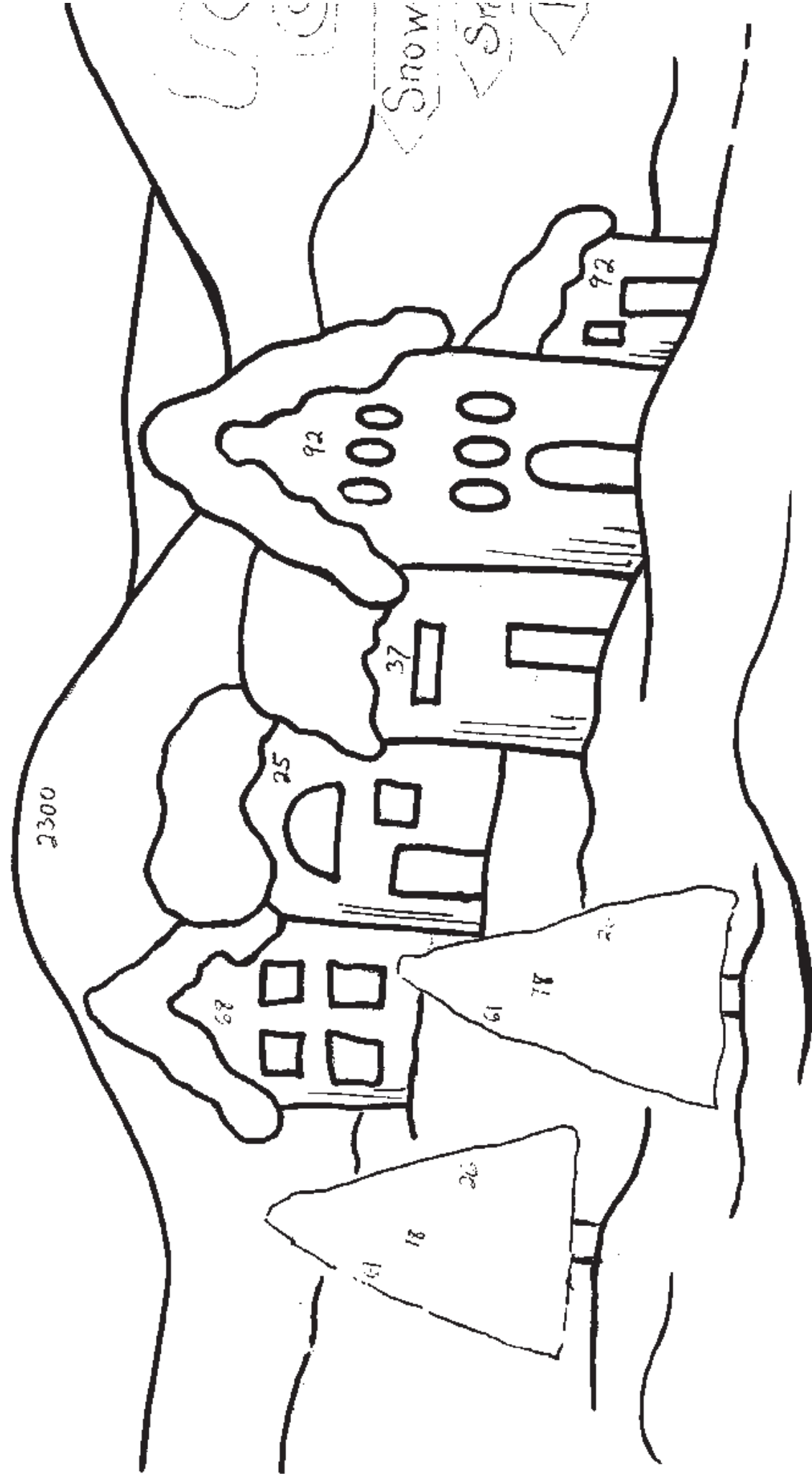
STEP 7- Wet your # 6 round brush and then dab only once on the paper towel so have still have plenty of water in your brush. Now slide one side of the brush through the edge of the Chocolate Moose then shade the left side of each house by sliding the glazed side of the brush along the inside edge of each house. Shade the snow the same way but using Lil Boy Blue and applying under each snow line. Also put a little of the blue shading on the snow that's on the roof of the houses.

STEP 8- Do the trees by dipping a small sponge into some Leap Frog and apply to the tree very uneven then apply Pea Soup over it in the same way, staying slightly to the right side of the tree. Now apply a little Fir Ever Green over that but also going to the right of the tree so that the tree has some dimension to it...from light to dark. See photo.

STEP 9- Outline all the houses, snow lines and the sign using Black Lab.
